Access to KG and the possibility to pursue education is essential for children and their development, as well as their future prospects as contributors to socio-economic development in their societies. All children have the right to protection and education and have opportunities for a successful and self-determined future.

The Project's implemented activities are Kindergarten Classes for KG1 & KG2 students Program targeting **260 students (4-6 years old)** who are not enrolled in any regular KG and aiming to prepare children academically, socially, cognitively and psychologically to enable them enroll in first grade in regular Kindergartens. Special attention will be given to **Children with Disabilities/CWD**. In addition to access to educational opportunities, children are supported through psychosocial measures. Teaching staff receives training to convey KG content to vulnerable children, while taking their specific needs into account. Parents and legal guardians of children are included in the program by facilitating their participation. Partner KGs benefit from an improvement in the KG infrastructure.
