



**Inclusive Education Support Project for Syrian and Jordanian Children (2025–2026)**

**Project Duration:** 01.09.2025 – 31.08.2026

**Governorate of Implementation:** Zarqa

Providing access to school and ensuring the continuation of education is essential for children and their development, as well as for their future aspirations as contributors to the social and economic development of their communities. All children have the right to protection and education, and to be given opportunities to achieve a successful future to determine their own educational and career paths.

During the 2025/2026 academic year, 150 Syrian and Jordanian children will participate in the Inclusive Learning Support Services in Schools program in Zarqa Governorate.

The program will provide Inclusive Learning Support Services classes one to two days per week over a period of 40 days. It will target children aged 6–12 years, focusing on bridging academic learning gaps, helping them catch up on missed lessons, and preparing them for exams.

Teaching staff receives training to convey school content to vulnerable children, while taking their specific needs into account. Parents and legal guardians of children are included in the program by facilitating their participation. Partner schools benefit from an improvement in the school infrastructure, in addition to providing cash-for-education assistance to 22 children with disabilities.
