

Health and MHPSS Services for Non-Syrian Refugees in Jordan (2026)

Duration: February 1, 2026 – January 31, 2027

Target Areas: Central Governorates Amman Balqa – Fuhais , Zarqa “ , South Governorates “Madabah”

Donor: Caritas Germany

This project aims to improve access to essential health services and mental health and psychosocial support (MHPSS) for non-Syrian refugees and vulnerable host communities in Jordan, particularly in Amman, Zarqa, Balqa, and Madaba. It addresses key barriers such as limited access to affordable healthcare and essential medications by providing primary and secondary healthcare services, as well as support for individuals living with chronic conditions.

In addition, the project strengthens psychosocial well-being and protection through case management, counseling services, and awareness activities, with a focus on vulnerable groups including women at risk and persons with disabilities. By integrating health and MHPSS interventions, the project contributes to improved quality of life, increased resilience, and enhanced protection outcomes for targeted communities.
