A New Health Project Agreement

Caritas Jordan in cooperation with Caritas Denmark with the fund of the Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs (DK MoFA) signed today an agreement for a new Project ***“Health Program for Syrian Refugees & Vulnerable Jordanians in Jordan”*** for a 4-year duration.

The Project aims to sustain the health care system through the services of the primary health care, secondary health care, chronic diseases, Mother& Child besides providing capacity building for the medical staff and promoting health by many awareness sessions. The Project targets Refugees and vulnerable Jordanians in the governorates of Huson, Mafraq and Amman.

The Project maintains health care promotion with the coordination of many stakeholders mainly the Ministry of Health in Jordan.

Volunteers Youth Camp 2022

Caritas Jordan began holding three youth volunteer camps, starting from July 23 to August 28, 2022, which aim to exchange experiences and promote social and voluntary work through field work with the needy and refugees, in cooperation and participation with “Non-Della Guerra”. The three camps gathered 60 young volunteers from Italy, two weeks in each camp in Jordan, specifically in the Latin parish of Madaba Governorate. The camps program includes many activities, including field visits, work with refugees in education projects implemented through the Education Unit and Business Definition Areas (Gardens of Mercy) through the Livelihoods Unit, provide support for parish activities, especially children’s summer camps, in addition to community work and organizing workshops and lectures.
